

Design Issue Focus Groups

- This service targets the needs of Owners that have people within their organization who have overlapping interests in the form and function of proposed new, or remodeled facilities.
- The goal of the Design Issue Focus Group is to bring these people together, and in a group forum discuss their varying and often opposing objectives and requirements, and establish a consensus all involved can embrace.

Construction Issue Resolution

- This service is intended to help Owners address specific project construction issues, and can be considered an adjunct to the Project Management Audit.

Project Management Audits

- Project Management Audits can occur during any phase of a project, whether it be planning, design or construction. The purpose of the audit is to determine, in a non-judgemental way, where the roadblocks to forward progress are on a project.
